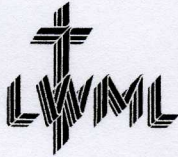
## It's All in the Message

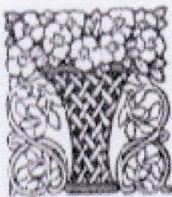

**The Hispanic Street Kids Outreach**

**Mission writes:** “Because of the grant you so graciously awarded us, we have been able to purchase a van to bring more youth to our Hispanic Ministry. Our latest baptism included 9 youths and 4 adults and took place in the Gulf of Mexico. What a day of celebration! There are 6 young people who have entered confirmation class. On Wednesday evening, the youth get together for worship, Bible study, and entertainment. The adults who attend have their own Bible class. The small children have their crafts and Bible stories. Between 50-70 people attend. One young man, a former Jehovah Witness, is thinking about the ministry as a career. Pastor Tony and Pastor JR join in asking God’s blessings on the LWML FL/GA district that they may continue to bless others as they have blessed us.”
